Saturday Painters – Summer 2008 Painting Schedule

Date	Place	Directions
5/3	Seiberling Naturealm	Take Riverview Rd south from Peninsula to Smith Road. Naturealm is on the left near the top of the big hill.
5/10	Village of Boston	From 303 in Peninsula go north on Riverview Rd to Boston Mills Rd. Go right (east) past the MD garage to the second parking lot.
5/17	Brandywine Falls	From Hudson take 303 W to Olde Route 8. Go north to Brandywine road and turn left. Turn in at the Brandywine Inn and follow the drive around to the parking lot. Alternative parking is available on the near side of the river behind the falls. Ohio Plein Air Society - May 17 Pine Tree Barn, Wooster (see www.ohiopleinairsociety.com)
5/24	Hampton Hills	Take Akron Peninsula Road south from Peninsula. The entry to the park is just past Steels Corner Rd. There is a nice creek down the path from the end of the parking lot.
5/31	Deep Lock Quarry	Take Riverview Road south from Peninsula. Entry point is on your left just past Heritage Farms
6/7	Chippewa Creek	Take Riverview north from Peninsula, past the park headquarters at Vaughn Rd. (Highland Rd) almost to Route 82. The turnoff to Station Road Bridge national park site will be on the right. Chippewa Creek Drive in the Brecksville Reservation is on your left (west). Go left. We will be painting at the ford in the creek.
6/14	ONeill Woods (lower bit)	Go South on Riverview to Bath Rd. Go West (right) to the first right (oddly enough this is still Bath Rd – if you had gone the other way you would have been on yellow creek). Once you are over the little creek you are in O'Neill Woods. Park along the sides of the road beyond the white barn and before the big hill. Ohio Plein Air Society – Buck Creek State Park Springfield, OH
6/21	Hudson's Square	On the northeast corner of RTE 91 and 303 HSA Clothesline Show at Hudson Middle School
6/28	CVAC Plein Air Paintout	Call Cuyahoga Valley Art Center for info.

CALENDAR:

Tuesday, June 17, 5:00 – 7:00 p.m.

Deliver artwork to the Barlow Community Center. Bring: 1) attached entry form, 2) completed list of entries, 3) a self-addressed stamped #10 envelope and 4) make sure the labels are attached to the front of artwork in the lower right corner.

Wednesday, June 18, 9:00 – 11:00 a.m.

Volunteers will hang the show at the Hudson Middle School.

Thursday and Friday, June 19 and 20

Show hours are from Noon to 5:00 p.m.

Saturday, June 21

Show hours are Noon to 5:00 p.m. Please pick-up unsold paintings between 4:30 and 5:30 p.m. Final take down and clean-up.

If delivery and/or pickup times ARE NOT convenient, please make arrangements to have someone transport your work accompanied with the appropriate paperwork.

ARTWORK: All pieces must be the original work of the participant. Two-dimensional work must have a neutral mat and wrapped in clear plastic. Pieces 20 x 24" or smaller will be hung. Each member may submit up to twelve (12) pieces.

SALES: A 10% commission will be charged on all sales.
