Greetings HSA Members,

During my trip to Alaska in August we visited the Alaska State Fair in Palmer. There I met and talked with some talented local artists. Of particular interest to me was James A Morris (www.sunjamstudios.com) who works with pen and colored inks. For some drawings he may have as many as 20 Rapidograph pens containing colored inks. The problem is that water-based colored ink dries more rapidly than india ink and cleaning pens is a time-consuming task. He does the usual animal drawings and has collection of humorous drawings he calls "comedy" on his web site. He also does aviation art with many drawings in that group. It's worth a look.

At the Anchorage Art Museum I saw two beautiful paintings by Rockwell

Kent. His block prints are numerous and familiar but I had never seen these two paintings reproduced. His autobiography, "It's Me O Lord" (Hudson Library-Biography section 709.2) is a fascinating account of his adventurous and dangerous life style as well as his personal and artistic life.
