**DROP-OFF/PICKUP:** See schedule above. If the drop-off and/or pickup times are not convenient, please make arrangements for someone to transport your art work. **ALL PIECES MUST BE PICKED UP BEFORE 2:00 P.M. ON SATURDAY JANUARY 14<sup>TH</sup>.**

**SALE OF ITEM:** Each artist must provide contact information and will be responsible for the sale of their artwork.

No entry fee – No commission – No juror – No prizes – No reception
