Members are required to volunteer a minimum of 4 hours each year assisting with HSA events and shows or donate 1(one) piece of original artwork for auction to support HAS's art student school scholarships.

- The *Student Membership is open to high school and college students interested in two dimensional and three-dimensional art (not performing arts) and requires no membership fee.
- HSA welcomes professional and non-professional artists as well as art lovers! Our twice monthly, non-obligatory, meetings are dedicated to visiting artists' demos. We also provide workshops; members' only shows and other perks.
- HSA's mission to promote public awareness of art and encourage artists in their pursuits is accomplished through the annual award of a scholarship to a graduating senior from Hudson High School, donating financial support to the Hudson Community Foundation and supporting other local art entities.
- Art on the Green is the annual HSA extravaganza which brings artist exhibitors and art lovers together on the last weekend in August. It also serves as a venue where HSA members can exhibit and sell their personal art.
