Old Business Items

1. Policy on membership deadlines and event eligibility.
New members may join HSA at any time of the year. There will be no prorating of the membership fee for late joiners. Members-only shows are open to all current members at the time of the show take-in date. A non-member may become eligible by submitting the membership form and fee payment before the take-in date. Similarly, a non-member may submit a membership form and payment prior to an HSA workshop and be able to attend at the members' rate.
2. Policy on juried shows
Any members-only show that is to be juried and have cash awards must have a submission fee that will cover show costs.
3. Policy on partial participation in HSA workshops
If an artist requests partial participation in a multi-day HSA workshop, that artist will be placed on a wait list and will be registered for the workshop only if openings remain at the close of the registration period. The fee for partial participation may be prorated as deemed appropriate by the board.
4. Proposal to adjust the timeframe for our meetings from 7:30-9:30 to 7:00-9:00
5. Proposal for Student Membership in HSA
High School or college students may join HSA under the provisions that there will be no membership fee and that students will be eligible to participate in members-only shows with no submission fee but with the requirement to work at the show. Student members may attend HSA workshops for a student fee to be approved by the board.
